
Please consider which of the following assembly options you prefer before you begin.

Option 1. Assemble as angled storage:

(Shelves slanted for shoes)

Option 2. Assemble as flat storage:


(Shelves level for clothing and accessories)



Assemble as angled storage (option 1):


Step 1: Hand screw two leveling feet (G) into the bottoms of left and right frames (A & B).

Step 2: Attach side frames (A & B) to the mesh shelves (C) using 12 hex screws (F). Tighten with hex wrench (H).



Step 3: Attach top **(D)** to base using four small hex screws **(E)** and a hex wrench **(H)**. Tighten the hex screws until the top is secure.


Step 4: Adjust leveling feet (G) as needed for stability.



Assemble as flat storage (option 2):

Step 1: Hand screw two leveling feet (G) into the bottoms of left and right frames (A & B).

Step 2: Attach side frames (A & B) to the mesh shelves (C) using 12 hex screws (F). Tighten with hex wrench (H).




Note: Make sure screw tabs are facing inward on both side frames (A & B).


Note: For flat storage assembly, start with the top mesh shelf. Use the first pre-drilled hole and skip the next pre-drilled hole. Continue until the last mesh shelf is installed.

Note: Make sure feet are on the bottom on all frames.

Step 3: Attach top **(D)** to base using four small hex screws **(E)** and a hex wrench **(H).** Tighten the hex screws until the top is secure.



Step 4: Adjust leveling feet **(G)** as needed for stability.
